Anti-Abolitionism and the Irish Cause

For our June 8th meeting, we welcome back Dr. Ian Delahanty. He will be speaking on his new book, Embracing Emancipation: A

Transatlantic History of Irish Americans, Slavery, and the American Union, 1840-1865. Delahanty, Associate Professor of History at Springfield College, is especially interested in how, during the Civil War era, Irish minds were changed from unflinching opposition to emancipation to seeing it as an ally of the Irish cause.
