For our November 13th meeting of the IHRT, we have the pleasure of a returning speaker, Bill Waldron, long time member of the IHRT and CTIAHS. Bill will be speaking on the sacred sites in ancient Ireland. These are sites, older than the Pyramids, which lift us out of time and the

everyday experience. The ancient Irish built shrines, believed to have healing magic, and carved elegant designs on dolmens. They had sweat houses and stone mounds. Join us for a stimulating talk at 7:30pm at the Knights of ST. Patrick hall, New Haven.
