Terence MacSwiney: Courage Against Power

Dave Hannigan, author

A newspaper columnist, adjunct professor of history and author, Dave Hannigan will return to the Irish History Round Table for a presentation about his latest book, "Terence MacSwiney: The Hunger Strike That Rocked An Empire."

A playwright, author and Sinn Fein politician, MacSwiney was elected lord mayor of Cork during the Irish War of Independence in 1920. Arrested and found guilty of sedition, he was imprisoned in Brixton prison in England. He died there in October after a 74-day hunger strike. His strike and death re-

verberated around the world and were among the major events in the successful final struggle of the Irish people for their independence.
